Grade A proteins and organic grains ♦ **Vegetable broth** (extremely nutrient-dense vegetables cooked in filtered water; all vegetables are organic except the green beans) ♦ **Carrots** ♦ **Green Beans** (for high-quality fiber and vitamin K) ♦ **Broccoli** (for immune system support and vitamin K) ♦ **Kale** (nutrient-dense, calcium, vitamin K, immune system support) ♦ **Garlic** (stimulates immune system; antibiotic and antiparasitic) ♦ **Flaxseed Meal** (high-quality fiber and antioxidant) ♦ **Omega-3 Fatty Acids** (for shiny coat and healthy skin) ♦ **Olive Oil** (for its natural preservative qualities, vitamin E, linoleic acid, and unsaturated fatty acid) ♦ **Thyme** (healing herb to soothe coughs and add respiratory support; antiseptic) ♦ **Rosemary** (energizing stimulant herb; antiseptic)
